Most, if not all, field trip activities will be conducted outside unless requested otherwise. Bring **sunscreen, bug spray, allergy medication, and extra water** in case you need it. We do have air conditioned restroom facilities, outdoor shower heads, and water fountains available. A picnic pavilion is available for lunch use by field trips if you prefer to eat here in addition to a playground if your group would like to stay past the end of the scheduled lessons/activities.

Class behavior is the responsibility of the teachers/chaperones. Supervision of the class by teachers and/or chaperones is required at all times and teacher/chaperone participation in lessons/activities is expected.

Our calendar fills up fast so it is **recommended that you request/schedule a field trip at least 2 months minimum in advance** of your requested date(s). We are not always able to reschedule field trips that are cancelled due to inclement weather.
